The PAN theme this year is 'All Change' and our display is linked to the work of Eric Carle. Classes have been looking at books such as 'One Tiny Seed,' 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar,' 'The Lonely Firefly' and 'The Mixed-Up Chameleon' and have based their artwork and poetry on these books.

PTFA Events

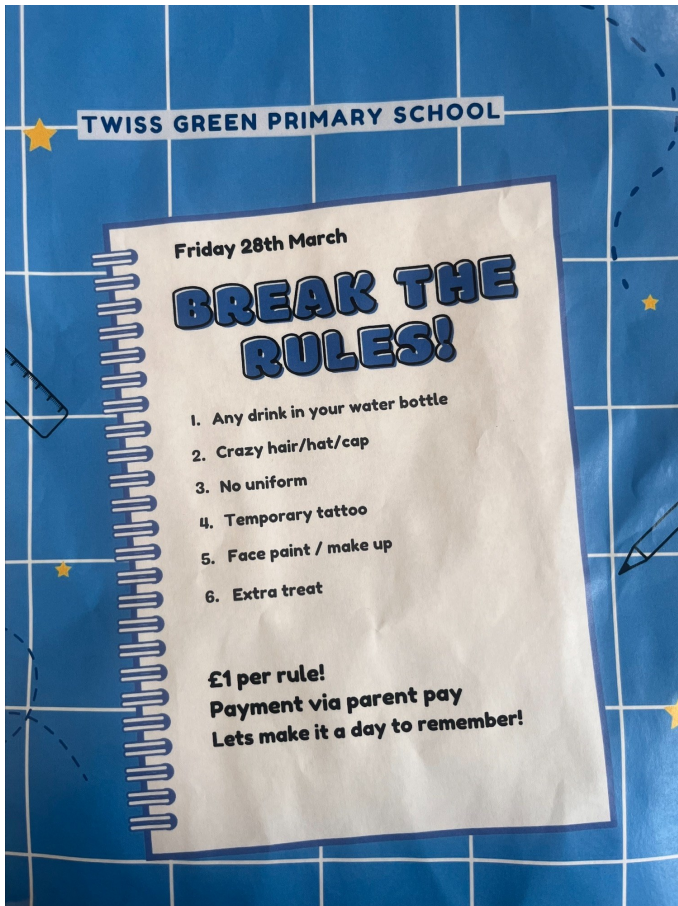
