## **Spotlight on Nursery!**

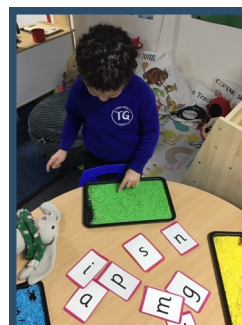
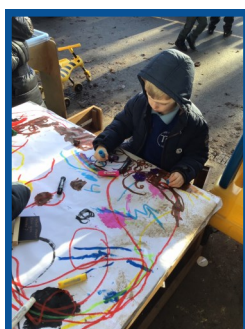
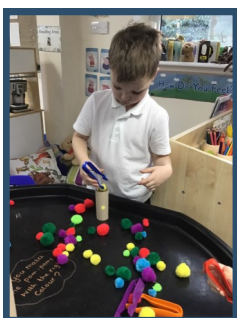
