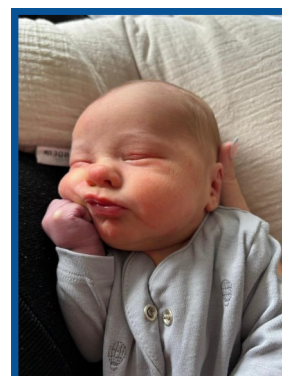
Caring for Our World
