Breakfast and After School Club

Earlier this year, we asked for your views on our Breakfast and After School Club provision. Thank you to everyone who took the time to share their feedback. We have carefully considered your responses alongside attendance patterns at After School Club this year and, as a result, the following changes will take effect from September:

- The cost of an After School Club session will remain the same, with the exception of Fridays (see below).
- Due to low demand for a 6.00pm finish, After School Club will now close at 5.45pm, Monday to Thursday.
- On Fridays, After School Club will finish at 5.30pm, with the cost of a session being £11.50.
- Our teacher-led extra-curricular clubs will cost £3 per session from September. If your child attends After School Club following one of these clubs, the cost of the After School Club session will be £9, reflecting the shorter session.
- There will be no changes to Breakfast Club timings or pricing.

Breakfast and After School Club sessions for September will be available to book early next week.

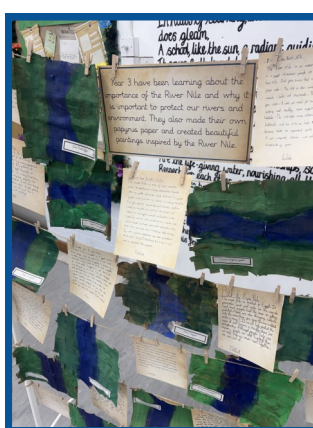
