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Parents' Evenings

Our autumn term parents' evenings are next Wednesday and Thursday, the 9th and 10th November. They are an opportunity for you to meet with your child's class teacher to discuss how they have settled into their new class, what is going well for them so far this term and what their next steps are. Please note, appointments will last for 10 minutes, so please make an additional appointment for another time with your child's class teacher if you would like to discuss something which may take longer than the allotted time.

This term, we are trialling holding all of our appointments in the hall. When you arrive, you will be directed to seating in the hall to wait for your appointment slot. After you have spoken to your child's teacher, they will give you your child's English and Maths books to look through. Once you have looked at your child's books, you will be able to leave them in a box on your way out.

Parents' evenings for Year 1 families have been rearranged and will now take place on Wednesday 30th November and Thursday 1st December.

Writing Curriculum Evening

On Wednesday 23rd November, parents and carers are invited into school for a writing curriculum evening. At 5pm, there will be a short presentation in the hall about how we teach writing at Twiss Green and what your child's writing journey looks like through school. Following this, there will be an opportunity to go into your child's classroom to talk to their class teacher about writing in their year group. Your child's English book will also be available for you to see their progress in writing so far this year, alongside the resources used to teach writing in class.

Writing is one of our key school improvement priorities for this year, so we hope you will join us to find out a little more about this important curriculum area.
