Thank you to those who were able to fill in our Breakfast and After School Club questionnaire. We are grateful for your feedback and for your very kind comments about our staff and the provision. 62% of those who responded said that they would find a 7.30am start for Breakfast Club useful. Therefore, we are pleased to announce that from September 2023, Breakfast Club will open at 7.30am.

During the summer term, our Governing Body will discuss feedback given to us in the questionnaire about our pricing structure and invoicing system and we will share any amendments we make to these as a result before the end of the summer term.

Our PTFA do a wonderful job of raising money for school which positively impacts on our children. Most recently, the Hoppy Easter Egg Hunt raised an impressive £540 and our children are very excited today about the PTFA break the rules day!
