### Covid Changes:

A more detailed Risk Assessment can be found on the website. These are the main points for return next week:

Symptomatic children will continue to be sent home for PCR tests.

NHS Track and Trace will ask for families close contacts—not school (except for exceptional cases.)

Close contacts do not need to isolate if under 18 1/2 or fully vaccinated.

Handwashing, extra cleaning and ventilation in school will continue.

Children can attend in PE kits on PE days.

Return to normal times for school day:  
KS2 8:50-3:20 , KS1 9:00-3:15.

All parents can come into the school grounds to pick up & drop off.

Return to school dinners available for all in the school hall.

Return to whole-school assemblies.

Remote learning to continue for pupils isolating.
