School Dinners

I would like to encourage more families to choose school dinners, especially over the winter months. We currently have around 95 children having a school dinner. If we begin to get 100+ an extra member of staff is sent for the kitchen team. This would make a significant difference to our team's workload. I am also having a bit of a push about how much the children throw away. In assembly this week I asked them how many families encouraged them to eat up and about 80% of the children said they were encouraged to eat their food at home and most said their families would be disappointed if they saw how much food they were throwing away. We are using gentle encouragement but hoping that we can have less waste.
